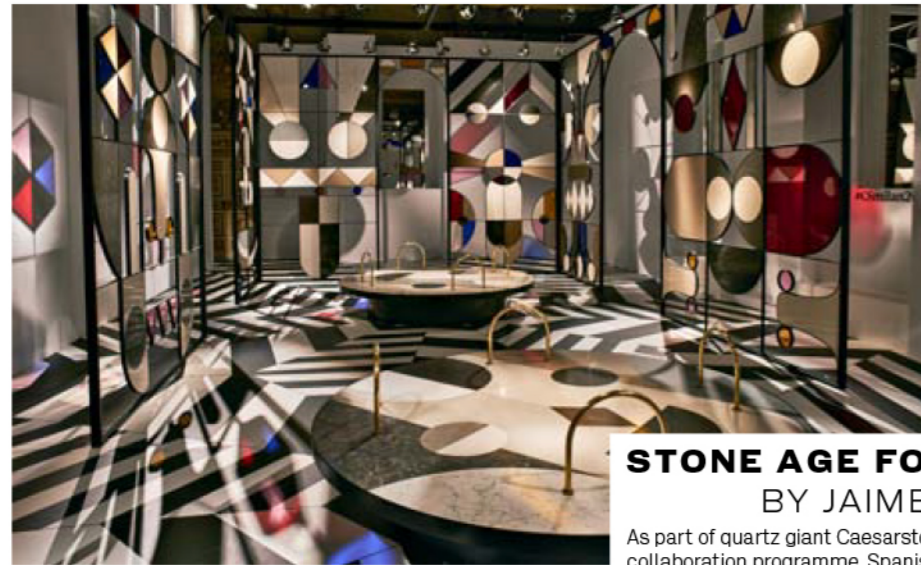


MIX IT UP BY PEPSICO

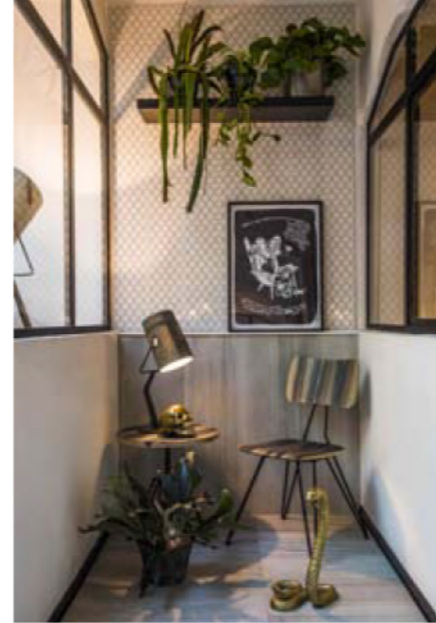

Salone del Mobile Milano's 56th edition showcased the best in international furniture, lighting and kitchen brands. Sneha Ullal Goel lists the key highlights



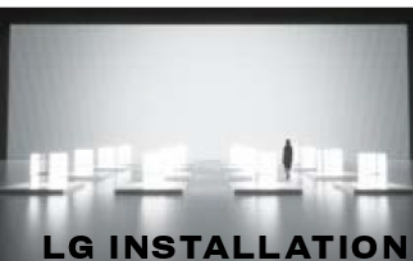
STONE AGE FOLK BY JAIME HAYON

As part of quartz giant Caesarstone's year-long designer collaboration programme, Spanish designer Jaime Hayon envisioned this architectural pavilion within Palazzo Serbelloni at Corso Venezia. Taking inspiration from the animal kingdom and folklore, he combined 40 Caesarstone colours with metal and stained glass. You couldn't miss the signature clown faces and tribal masks, displayed alongside fun carousels that supported handcrafted furniture and lighting.

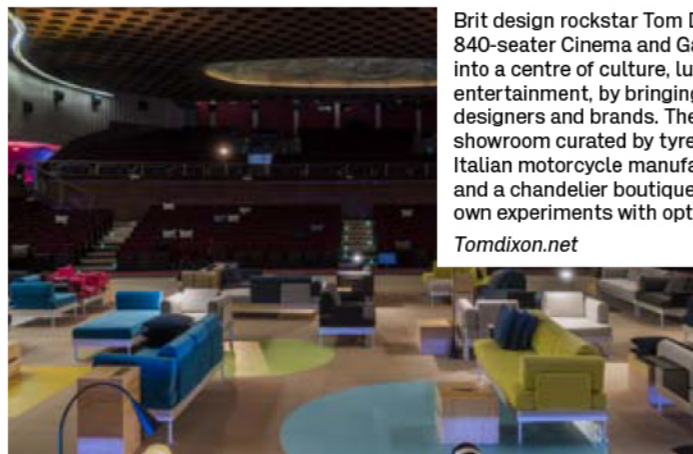
THE POP-UP HOME BY DIESEL LIVING

Best known for its tongue-in-cheek approach to design, the furniture brand took up in a 1930s goldsmith's workshop for a week. Located in the heart of Milan at Via Cesare Correnti, the glass-roofed edifice formed the perfect industrial backdrop for the brand's new and iconic furniture. The section we loved featured the grunge-chic kitchen combined with the dining area, decked with open shelving, dark marble-topped tables and steel chairs with perforated backs.

LG INSTALLATION BY TOKUJIN YOSHIOKA

To mark its milestone 70th anniversary, LG roped in Japanese designer Tokujin Yoshioka to create an installation called S.F. Senses Of The Future. Comprising 30,000 LG OLED panels, 'The Wall Of The Sun' formed the backdrop to a grid of chairs, each made from OLED panels displaying different coloured lighting effects.

MULTIPLEX BY TOM DIXON

Brit design rockstar Tom Dixon turned the 840-seater Cinema and Galleria on Via Manzoni into a centre of culture, luxury shopping and entertainment, by bringing aboard independent designers and brands.
